SPAG

Pronouns, capital letters, full stops, commas, suffixes, apostrophes, question marks, exclamation marks, verbs, suffixes and adverbs.

PSHE

Choices and challenges. Awareness of changes in our bodies.

Music

Using vocabulary including pulse, tempo, dynamics, timbre, pitch texture, structure and rhythm. Performing to music.

RE

Islam. Life as a Muslim. The 5 pillars of Islam. The Prophet Mohammad.

Understanding the significance of sacred places to different religions. Recognising religious symbols and their meaning.

Numeracy

Place value. Comparing and ordering numbers. Effective addition and subtraction strategies. facts. Doubles and halves. Counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's. The inverse relationships of addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. 2D and 3D shapes and their properties including symmetry. Units of measure for length, mass and capacity. Money. Time. Statistics (Yr 2).
