Upcoming Highway Improvement Works – Bridgnorth

Dear Customer,

We are writing to inform you of upcoming highway improvement works that will be taking place in your area.

What works are being carried out?

Underhill Street & Hollybush Road – Carriageway Resurfacing – 9:30am – 4pm

New Road & West Castle Street – Resurfacing & Rock Face works - 24hr Closure

A map is provided for reference.

When is this happening?

The works are scheduled to take place between **Monday 14th September and Friday 2nd October**.

Please be aware that these dates may change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Any updates will be shown on local advance warning signs and on <https://one.network/>

The works will be completed under road closures in the following phases.

Phase 1 & Rock Face

Underhill Street, from Low Town Bridge to the B4363 Jct

14th September to 18th September - 09:30am to 4:00pm

New Road & West Castle Street

14th September to 18th September – 24hr Closure

Access to Oldbury Wells School will be maintained from the north via Pound Street.

Two-way temporary traffic lights will be in operation at the B4373 junction and Oldbury Road to manage traffic movements.

Phase 2 - Hollybush Road, B4364 Jct to Oldbury Wells School Jct

21st September to 25th September - 09:30am to 4:00pm

Access to Oldbury Wells School will be maintained from the north via Pound Street.

Temporary traffic lights will be in operation at the B4363/Oldbury Road Jct and B4373/Oldbury Wells jct to manage traffic movements.

Phase 3 – Between Oldbury Wells School Jct and Pound Street/Listley Street roundabout.

28th September to 2nd October - 09:30am to 4:00pm

Access to Oldbury Wells School will be maintained from the south via Underhill Street.

Two-way temporary traffic lights will be in operation at the B4373/Oldbury Wells Jct to manage traffic movements.

How will this affect traffic?

A signed diversion route will be in place for the duration of the closure.

Will there be access to my property/business?

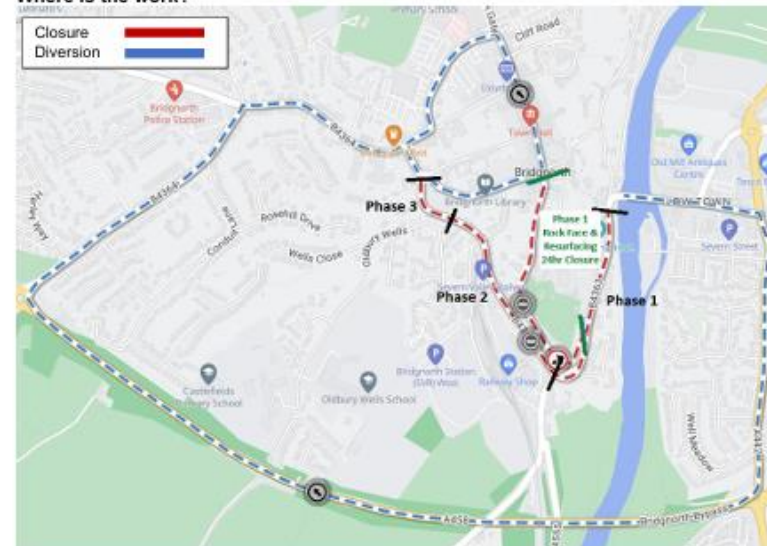
If you are looking to gain access to a property or business within the closure, we will provide access, however **vehicle access may be restricted** during working hours.

Our on-site team will assist where possible. Our priority is to keep you and our staff safe however there may be delays or times when vehicle access cannot safely be provided.

During the work, access to the works area will be restricted to:

- Residents who live and reside within the road closure.
- Businesses located within the closure (if applicable)
- Pedestrians, dismounted cyclists and equestrians
- Emergency vehicles (blue light calls)

Dear Parent/Carer of Year 6 Child

Your child is due to transfer to secondary school in September 2027. The online application process opens on the 1 September 2026 and closes on 31st October 2026. A letter will be sent home with your child, outlining the process. Alternatively, please follow this link – [Apply to start or transfer school | Shropshire Council](#) which takes you to the Shropshire Council Admissions website. Details about secondary school open evenings can be found in the Parents' Guide to Secondary Education in Shropshire booklet, on the same website

Applications received by Shropshire Council after the closing date will be classed as late, which may result in your child being disadvantaged, so please ensure you make your application on time. Late applications will not be processed until all on-time applications have been offered.

You can name up to four schools on your application – we encourage parents to make full use of these preferences. If only one preference is named, and we cannot offer this, we will have no choice on National Offer Day but to offer a place at the next nearest school with a vacancy, which could be a considerable distance from your home address.
